To Teach who Christ Is Capital Campaign

- Gary Martin led the discussion of how the Capital campaign dollars will be allocated
- Had much discussion about the various needs of the Parish
- Determined there will be four pillars of the Campaign
 1. Create a Social Justice Endowment - 10% of funds received
 2. Improving Catholic Education Experience – 50% of funds received
 3. Improving Spirituality and Worship Space – 35% of funds received
 4. Creating the Ten Year Vision for the Parish – 5% of funds received
 - a. This will be Stage 1 of the Capital Campaign for the Campus
